

SPECIAL SESSION

October 1, 2020

The Council of the City of Chardon met in Special Session on Thursday, October 1, 2020 at 6:30 PM via video-conferencing service, Zoom (Meeting ID: 837 8384 9655).

Daniel Meleski, President of Council presiding.

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance and roll call.

Members of Council present: Andrew Blackley, Deborah Chuha, Chris Grau, Heather Means, Daniel Meleski, Jeffrey Smock.

Members of Council absent: Nancy McArthur.

Others Present: City Manager Randal Sharpe, Finance Director Mate Rogonjic, Law Director Benjamin Chojnacki, Clerk of Council Amy Day, Public Service Director Paul Hornyak, Community Development Administrator Steven Yaney, Majeed Makhoulf.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mr. Blackley moved and Mrs. Chuha seconded to adjourn to Executive Session at 6:33 PM to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, promotion, demotion, discipline or compensation of a public employee or official, to consider the purchase of property for a public purpose or the sale of property at competitive bidding, and for conferences with the attorney for the public body concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or eminent court action, and invite Paul Hornyak, Steve Yaney and Majeed Makhoulf into the session.

Upon roll call vote the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion occurred regarding the purchase of property for a public purpose or the sale of property at competitive bidding.

Mr. Yaney and Mr. Hornyak were excused from Executive Session.

Discussion occurred concerning disputes that are the subject of eminent or pending court action.

Discussion occurred regarding the appointment, employment, dismissal, promotion, demotion, discipline or compensation of a public employee or official.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Sharpe stated that Council approval is being requested to increase the girls' travel basketball program fee so that it is the same as the boys' travel basketball program. Currently, the girls' program fee is \$350 and the boys' fee is \$375. The girls used to be in a different league and now they will be in the same league as the boys' program. Since both programs will have the same opportunities, he is requesting the fees be the same. Council authorization is required to change recreational program fees that are over \$250.

Mr. Smock moved and Ms. Means seconded to adjust the girls' travel basketball program fee as proposed by the City Manager. Upon roll call vote the motion passed unanimously.

Public Service Director Paul Hornyak asked for Council's feedback on their preference of the Nature Stone color selection for the floor of the gazebo.

After discussion and input from Council, members requested the Public Service Director share their comments with the City Architect and let him choose the style of the flooring.
